#### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with TECHLINE PIPE for the purchase of fire hydrants for the Austin Water Utility in an amount not to exceed \$1,906,875 with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$635,625 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$3,178,125.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$52,969 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013 – 2014 Operating Budget of the Austin Water Utility. Funding for the 20-months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This contract will provide for the purchase of approximately 541 fire hydrants of various sizes annually on an as needed basis. Fire hydrants are installed by the Austin Water Utility line maintenance crews and rehabilitation crews where City water mains exist within the City's water service area.

New hydrants are installed when existing hydrants cannot be repaired or have been destroyed. Installation is governed by the Fire Code and the Land Development Code. In addition to fire protection, fire hydrants are used for monitoring static flowing water pressure, flushing out mains after repairs, and purging trapped air.
