1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- The next step to move forward with the "one stop shop" resource center for Veterans in Austin would be to acquiring property and surveying Veterans for their top priorities and resources needed. The board has agreed to propose and recommend for a Vista to look and search for resources.

- Christopher Araugjo, Military Veteran Peer Network (MVPN) Volunteer Coordinator informed the board about the organization's mission and goals to benefit and assist Veterans. The organization provides peer support for other Veterans and is partnered with other organizations to provide services to Veterans and service members. They provide mental health support and activities to reintegrate them back into the community.
- The Commission discussed the possibility of being involved and volunteering with other organizations to provide support and have a presence with the Veteran community. Chair Cassaundra informed the board that volunteering is not a requirement to serve on the commission.
- The Commission agreed to make an appearance at organizations and events to support and assist Veterans and Service members in the community.
