Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply agreement with SUN TINT, INC. to provide automotive window tinting services in an amount not to exceed \$125,034, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$41,678 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$250,068.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$13,893 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Department. Funding for the remaining 32-months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
