**Additional Backup Information**

The Parks and Recreation Department received a request on August 8, 2013 to name the two acre parkland located at 3000 Del Curto Rd, near South Lamar Boulevard. On October 23, 2013, the City of Austin Public Information Office (PIO) began the official 90-day period requesting nominations from the general public to name the parkland.

After the 90-day period, which ended on January 20, 2014, PARD received 2 nominations for the re-naming of the park. On April 14, 2014, the Land, Facilities, and Programs Committee of the Parks and Recreation Board heard public comment on the suggested names and forwarded the name Del Curto Neighborhood Park to the Parks & Recreation Board for action. On April 22, 2014, the Parks and Recreation Board unanimously voted to recommend the name of Del Curto Neighborhood Park to the City Council.
