The PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD / ENVIRONMENTAL BOARD JOINT COMMITTEE convened in a joint meeting on Tuesday, January 21, 2014, at City Hall, 301 West 2nd Street, Austin, Texas.

1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

3. STAFF BRIEFINGS AND DISCUSSION

 Robin Camp (Public Works Department Project Manager) introduced Brian Larson of Larson, Burns and Smith, who provided an overview of the approved lighting plan for the General Grounds Improvements project.

- Committee chair, Hill Abell, asked why the flood lights specified were chosen.
- Mr. Larson responded that the fixtures were recommended by their lighting consultant because of the light spread and ability to adjust beam directions. Also, when lighting plan was designed, no available LED fixtures were suitable for this application.
- Robin Camp gave an update on the progress of the General Grounds Improvements project.
 - Committee members asked about the unscheduled closure of the hike-and-bike trail on the south side of Barton Springs.
 - Ms. Camp replied that she was unaware of the unscheduled closure, but that
 it was likely due to the contractor working over weekends to make up lost
 time. She also stated that more care would be taken to notify the public of
 imminent trail closures.
