

INFRASTRUCTURE

- \$20K lighting installed at Widen by AISD. 10 Widen/GAVA/AI parent leaders involved
- \$300K sidewalk improvements installed at Ponciana Park. Additional plan for \$100K in improvements created by 30+ GAVA/44 resident leaders
- \$13K Austin Parks Foundation (APF) grant for park improvements at Franklin Park implemented
- \$12K APF grant for park improvements at Dove Springs District Park implemented
- 1,000 free fruit and nut trees were planted by COA, involving 50+ resident volunteers
- \$15K speed bumps approved for installation in neighborhood streets
- \$450K APF and St. David's grant for improvements at Dove Springs District Park in progress

PROGRAMMING

- Soccer program at Rodriguez, Houston, Widen estimated \$5k worth of PA programming implemented at \$0 cost, served estimated 200 students, and run by 35 parents
- 8 free programs and 2 reduced cost programs will be added at the DS Rec Center in 2014
- SRTS events conducted at Perez, Rodriguez, Langford
- Staff Wellness Committee established at Widen
- SFC collaborated with Mendez staff to offer after-school programming
- YMCA began offering MEND program at Langford
- Sustainable food gardening workshops at La Paloma
- River City Youth Foundation garden installation

POLICY

- Residents stopped a convenience store on Bluff Springs Road from being built 1000ft from an elementary school which would have sold unhealthy foods and alcohol near students
- City HHS department approved a GAVA solicited policy change to require HHS funded providers serving nearly 1k youth to serve healthy and nutritious snacks during afterschool programming
- PARD increased the number of youth scholarships that pay 75% cost of programming fees.
 Currently Dove Springs Recreation Center has 70 youth enrolled in the scholarship program

- Increased participation in Summer Playground Program (2 sites) Served 100+ youth 40 hours a week for active summer programming in neighborhood parks and playgrounds
- Dove Springs Recreation Center is now open 4 additional hours each week on Saturday and is serving an additional 50 youth each week compared to when the hours were reduced
