Additional Backup Information

The proposed Austin Oaks Planned Unit Development (PUD) is a 31.37-acre mixed use project generally located at the southeast corner of Spicewood Springs Road and MoPac Expressway, and includes residential, office, and retail components. Though still in a conceptual planning stage, the project may include 610 townhome and multifamily units, 850,000 square feet of office space, and 100,000 square feet of retail.

The project is unique in at least two ways. First, the proposed PUD is for the redevelopment of existing multistory office buildings dating from the 1970s and 1980s, rather than the development of a vacant or undeveloped site. Second, the proposed PUD includes the existing street network, with PUD areas on both the north and south sides of Executive Center Drive, and both the east and west sides of Wood Hollow Drive.

The development assessment process requires city staff to present the PUD to City Council at an early stage of the staff review process for Council's consideration and input. City staff will continue their review, and the PUD will be presented to City Council for final approval at a later date.
