This contract is to provide a diesel powered articulating boom lift which includes preventative maintenance and repair services for the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). This lift will be used for maintenance and repairs to the ABIA campus streetlights, parking lot lights, exterior building lights, and Federal Aviation Administration required obstruction lights. The boom lift will also be used for windowpane replacements, exterior building cleaning, sealing, and banner installation. This purchase is necessary to increase the effectiveness of ABIA maintenance programs.
