Current code does not allow sign placement on right-of-way installations, such as bicycle kiosks and bus stops. On March 20, 2014, Council approved a resolution initiating amendments to City Code Chapter 25-10 and directing the City Manager to process an ordinance authorizing logos on certain right-of-way installations. The proposed change will allow signs that identify an operator or sponsor to be placed on legally permitted right-of-way installations.
