- 3) The CAG has been in existence for over a year. What is the significance of this meeting to the CAG? We are coming to you, giving you input—you are supposed to be doing outreach. Is this meeting just an opportunity to check an item off on the CAG's to do list?
- 4) Given the composition of the CAG, business interests are well represented. There is only one member who represents the common people who live in Austin's neighborhoods, those folks who are participating, in good faith, in the CodeNEXT process. How is this a fair and balanced process if the CAG is stacked?
