Background Information

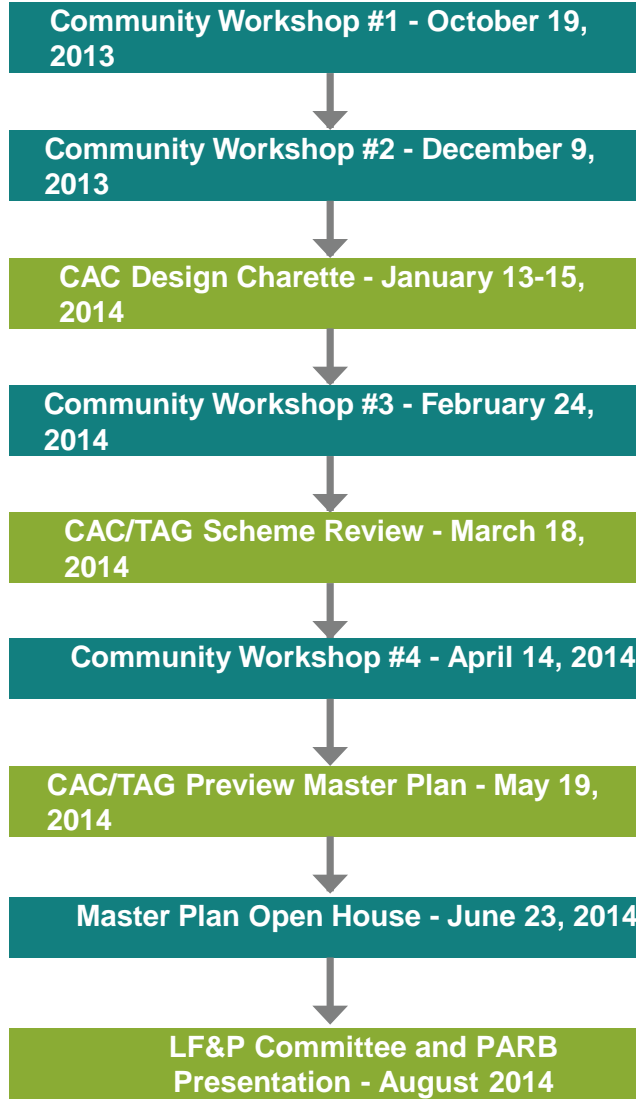
- 95 acres

- Provide park amenities based on stakeholder input

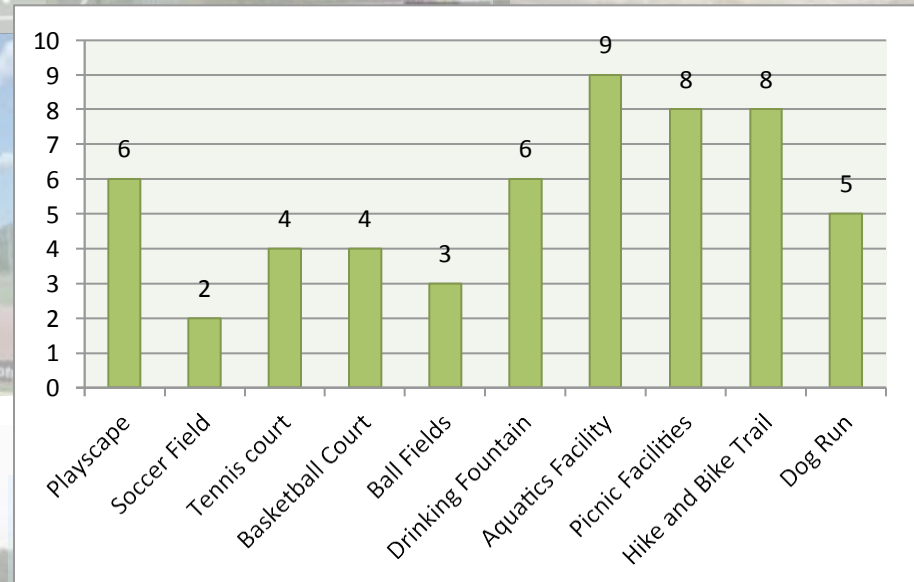
PLANNING PROCESS

2. Picnic Pavilion
3. Hike and Bike Trail

6. Dog Run
7. Tennis Court
8. Basketball Court
9. Ball Fields
10. Soccer Field
