**A. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON APPLICATIONS FOR HISTORIC ZONING and ACTIONS ON HISTORICALLY-ZONED PARCELS**

1. C14H-2014-0007 – Red River International House

**3805 Red River Street**

Applicant: Historic Landmark Commission

Owner: Delta H Corporation

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning if the structural engineer's report is positive for preservation.

Caroine Wright, Alyson McGee, Evan Thompson, Gregory Smith, Tere O'Connell, Linda Team, Linda Guerrero, Anne Harris, Robert Mace, Kim Barker and Kathy Echols spoke in support. Karen Browning, Matt Williams and Jim Bennett spoke in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**MOTION: Recommend historic zoning on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.**

**2. C14H-2014-0009 – Clappart-Bannerman-Castro House  
1207 E. 8<sup>th</sup> Street**

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning.

**3907 Avenue C (Hyde Park)**

Proposal: Construct a two-story rear addition, replace the front windows, and reconfigure the front stoop.

Applicant: Doug Keating, architect

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Committee Recommendation: Approve as proposed.

Staff Recommendation: Approve as proposed.

**MOTION:** Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness as proposed; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**2. LHD-2014-0487**

**4001 Avenue H (Hyde Park)**

Proposal: Construct a connector between the house and garage apartment; reconfigure the garage apartment.

Applicant: Wall 2 Wall Construction

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Committee Recommendation: Approve as proposed.

Staff Recommendation: Approve as proposed.

**MOTION:** Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness as proposed; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**3. C14H-2010-0009 – Voss House**

**1501 Northwood Road**

Proposal: Construct a new wood fence around the side and back of the house.

Applicant: David Roberts, owner

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Committee Recommendation: Not reviewed.

Staff Recommendation: Approve as proposed.

**MOTION:** Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness as proposed; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**C. REVIEW OF PERMITS IN NATIONAL REGISTER HISTORIC DISTRICTS**

**1. NRD-2014-0058**

**1003 Shelley Avenue (West Line)**

Proposal: Construct a two-story rear addition and a one-story side addition; reconfigure the front windows of a ca. 1923 contributing house; construct a garage apartment.

Applicant: Tara Kaminski, Gossett Jones Homes

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Lower and simplify the roofline of the proposed two-story addition; avoid a blank wall on the front of the two-story addition;

maintain the existing fenestration pattern on the front of the existing house; avoid the metal-roofed awning proposed for the front windows. Approve the garage apartment as proposed.

Jared Gossett spoke in support of the project. There were no speakers in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry. Commissioner Galindo second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**COMMENTS:**        **Take the addition to a single gable in place of a double gable. Do not change the windows on the front façade from a single window configuration to a side by side double configuration.**

**2.        NRD-2014-0062**

**2211 Windsor Road (Old West Austin)**

Proposal:        Remove non-historic additions, and construct new additions.

Applicant:       Tina Contros

City Staff:       Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation:    Approve as proposed with the recommendation that the applicant maintain the existing front entry gable rather than the horizontally-configured roofline proposed to maintain more of the historic appearance of the house.

**COMMENTS:**        **No additional comments to the staff recommendation.**

**3.        NRD-2014-0064**

**2702 Jefferson Street (Old West Austin)**

Proposal:        Demolish a ca. 1942 house.

Applicant:       Tom Blackwell

City Staff:       Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation:    Recommend adaptive re-use or relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package and the Commission's review of plans for new construction on the site.

**COMMENTS:**        **No additional comments to the staff recommendation.**

**4.        NRD-2014-0067**

**1514 W. 29<sup>th</sup> Street (Old West Austin)**

Proposal:        Construct a two-story garage with studio at the rear of the lot.

Applicant:       Elizabeth Purcell

City Staff:       Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation:    Approve as proposed.

**COMMENTS:**        **No additional comments to the staff recommendation.**

**5.        NRD-2014-0073**

**515 Congress Avenue (Congress Avenue and Sixth Street)**

Proposal: Install a new blade sign and a new wall sign for P.Terry's Burgers.

Applicant: Maggie Star

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Approve the size of the signs, but deny the exposed neon lighting.

Matt Ates, Patrick Terry and Evan Thompson spoke in support of the proposed design. There were no speakers in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**MOTION:** follow staff recommendation to approve the sign without the exposed neon lighting on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Galindo second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

6. **NRD-2014-0034**  
1504 Northwood Road – POSTPONE TO August 25, 2014 so the applicant can complete zoning review.

**MOTION:** Post-pone the public hearing to August 25, 2014 on a motion by Commissioner Galindo. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**D. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON APPLICATIONS FOR DEMOLITION OR RELOCATION**

1. **HDP-2014-0440 – POSTPONE TO August 25, 2014.**  
**1008 E. 9th Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1885 house.

Applicant: Jeff Krolicki, Dick Clark Architecture

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Postpone to August 25, 2014; the owners are considering restoration and rehabilitation of the house rather than demolition.

**MOTION:** Post-pone the public hearing to August 25, 2014 on a motion by Commissioner Galindo. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

2. **HDP-2014-0470**  
**1704 Eva Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1906 house.

Applicant: Stephen Finnerty

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Encourage rehabilitation and re-use if feasible, but otherwise release the permit and strongly encourage the applicant to

consider the scale and architectural context of the surrounding historic houses in the neighborhood in designing a new house for this site.

**MOTION:** Release the demolition permit in accordance with the staff recommendation; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**3. HDP-2014-0491**

**3402 Clawson Road**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1950 house.

Applicant: Max Hambly

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Strongly encourage the applicant to reconsider demolition and rehabilitate and reuse the existing house and setting if feasible; but otherwise, release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

David Jones and Marsha Topham spoke in support of the demolition. Sharron Howell originally signed to speak in opposition but spoke in support after finding out more information. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Galindo. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**MOTION:** Support the staff recommendation to release the demolition permit on a motion by Commissioner Roberts. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**4. HDP-2014-0495**

**1109 Angelina Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1950 to outside the city.

Applicant: Sherry Chang

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

There were no speakers in support or in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**MOTION:** Release the permit in accordance with staff's recommendation and encourage the applicant to relocate the house over demolishing on a motion by Commissioner Roberts. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**5. HDP-2014-0553**

**1106 Woodland Avenue**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1939 house and a ca. 1948 secondary dwelling unit.

Applicant: Jeff Bridgewater

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Release the permit for the secondary dwelling unit but postpone the hearing on the main house to August 25, 2014 to explore alternatives to demolition.

**MOTION: Post-poner the public hearing to August 25, 2014 on a motion by Commissioner Galindo. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.**

**6. HDP-2014-0566**

**905 W. Johanna Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1948 house.

Applicant: Moore-Tate Projects and Design

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Encourage adaptive re-use of the house if feasible, then recommend relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

**MOTION: Release the demolition permit in accordance with the staff recommendation; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.**

**7. HDP-2014-0567**

**1901 Willow Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1922 house.

Applicant: Harsh Doshy

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Encourage retention and re-purposing to the greatest extent possible, but if not feasible, then encourage relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

**MOTION: Release the demolition permit in accordance with the staff recommendation; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.**

**8. HDP-2014-0568**

**206 E. Live Oak Street**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1926 house with a ca. 1939 addition.

Applicant: Don Garner

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Initiate historic zoning.

Don Garner spoke in support of relocation over demolition. Eric Thompson spoke in opposition to demolition and relocation. Tom Hatch provided clarifying comments to support relocation. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry. Commissioner Galindo second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**MOTION:** Postpone the public hearing to August 25, 2014 to allow staff to do additional research on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**9. HDP-2014-0569**

**1902 New York Avenue**

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1915 house.

Applicant: Miller Construction

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Encourage rehabilitation and re-use of the structure if it is structurally sound. If not, then encourage relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

**MOTION:** Release the demolition permit in accordance with the staff recommendation; as per passage of the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts second the motion on a 5-0 vote.

**V. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON DEMOLITION BY NEGLECT CASES.**

**1. DBN-2014-0001 – 907, 909, and 911 Congress Avenue.**

Postpone to August 25, 2014 for further progress on remedying the site conditions and proposing a rehabilitation plan for the buildings.

**MOTION:** Post-pone the public hearing to August 25, 2014 on a motion by Commissioner Galindo. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second the motion on a 5-0 vote.
