<u>Description:</u> Consider an ordinance to amend Title 25 of the City Code to allow independent school districts to install and modify temporary, non-electronic, signs without a sign permit.

Summary

 Allows public education facilities to install signs on fences or buildings on the property.

Background: Initiated by Planning Commission on November 12, 2013.

Current code does allow school districts to temporarily display signs without first requiring a sign permit. The proposed change will allow temporary installation of a sign on the school's premises, with provisions regulating the length of time the sign may be installed, and the size of the sign.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends the proposed code amendment.

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 25-10 RELATING TO TEMPORARY SIGNS FOR SCHOOLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** Section 25-10-101 (Signs Allowed in All Sign Districts Without an Installation Permit) is amended to add a new Subsection (R) to read as follows and to redesignate the remaining subsection accordingly:
 - (R) A sign or banner installed by a public educational facility on a legally permitted building or fence located on the facility's property is permitted, except that the sign may not be displayed for more than 150 days consecutively.
