4. Discussion: Equipment requirements for City of Austin Google Fiber Community Connections (Teri Pennington, Deputy Chief Information Officer, Communications & Technology Management Department)

Ms. Teri Pennington and Mr. Joe Faulk spoke about the cost of the upgrades and ongoing maintenance to equipment that will be necessary to accommodate the Google Fiber Community Connections. Some of the City facilities have newer equipment that have the ability to interface easier and be less expensive, while some locations are older and have equipment that will need to be replaced or upgraded.

5. Presentation and Discussion: Innovation Officer and IT Data Architect priorities and functions (Ted Lehr, IT Data Architect, Communications & Technology Management Department; Kerry O'Connor, Innovation Officer)

Ms. Kerry O'Connor and Mr. Ted Lehr spoke about the collection of data on ongoing projects throughout the City and how the Innovation Office will assist with the various projects. The Innovation Office will provide suggestions for processes that may make the projects run more smoothly and suggestions to use data in different ways and for different purposes, as well as providing introductions between departments to expand collaboration.
