# Process Overview



**Purpose:** In the event that a recommended Google Fiber Community Connections site does not get implemented, the City Manager will collect suggestions for a replacement site from City Council members and provide this to the Emerging Technology and Telecommunications Council Committee (*Resolution 20131212-070*)

There are two sites on the approved list that, due to changes in the status of their locations, will not be implemented, as follows:
