

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING PERMIT FEE REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY FOOD EVENTS AT AUSTIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT EVENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. FINDINGS.

- (A) On January 10, 2008, Council approved a Memorandum of Cooperation with the Austin Independent School District (AISD) waiving the permit fee requirement for temporary food events on an AISD school campus, sponsored by AISD schools or any and all school-related, non-profit entities.
- (B) Temporary food event permits are necessary to allow the tracking of any food-related problems or incidents originating from booths at temporary food events.
- (C) The goal of the permit fee requirement for temporary food events is the prevention of foodborne illnesses at outdoor and/or temporary events resulting from the distribution of food originating from unapproved sources and the mishandling of food.
- (D) Through cooperation with AISD, the waiver of temporary food event permit fees will benefit the students and public school community by promoting continued educational and fund-raising events conducted in a safe and prudent manner at AISD school campuses.

PART 2. FEE WAIVERS.

Council waives the requirement of City Code Chapter 10-3 regarding temporary food event permit fees for events on an AISD school campus, sponsored by AISD schools or any and all school-related, non-profit entities. All AISD food events shall follow the City's temporary food service guidelines.
