Additional Backup Information

City Code § 1-3-4(7) pertaining to non-peace officers being authorized to write citations under specified conditions requires the **signature** of the person writing the citation. This is not a requirement for peace officers writing citations in state law. The name of the officer must be given but not an actual signature. The non-peace officer's name legibly printed on the citation should be sufficient.

Some advantages are:

- (1) Hand held ticket writers, which are becoming more and more widespread, can easily print the name of the officer logging into the device. But to also collect a signature, the current software in the handheld ticket writer would have to be modified to store the officer's signature.
- (2) Paper citations will continue to be used where they are a more efficient use of resources. Cursive signatures are often difficult to read and a printed name would be preferable.
- (3) In this technological age, printed names are becoming more and more acceptable, especially when the person has a personal password as is the case with handheld ticket writers.

The Law Department has favorably reviewed the proposal.
