AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20131212-071 TO INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR THE PRESIDING JUDGE AND ASSOCIATE JUDGES OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Part 6 of Ordinance No. 20131212-071 is amended and compensation for the Presiding Judge \$5,348.62 per pay period, annualized to \$139,064.00, paid in accord with normal payroll practices.

PART 2. Part 7 of Ordinance No. 20131212-071 is amended and compensation for an Associate Judge, including the Downtown Austin Community Court Judge, is \$4,636.31 per pay period, annualized to \$120,544.00, paid in accord with normal payroll practices.

PART 3. This ordinance does not repeal or otherwise affect Ordinance No. 20101028-047.

PART 4. The council finds that establishing appropriate judicial compensation constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, the ordinance takes effect October 5, 2014, which is the first day of the next pay period.
