ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The mission of the Kids Cafe Program is to help alleviate child hunger in America through the provision of nutritious meals served to children at-risk of hunger in safe, accessible sites. The Kids Cafe Program also includes nutrition education and enrichment activities.

The purpose of this request and additional grant funds is to allow the department to establish a new Kids Cafe Program site at the Turner Roberts Recreation Center, which serves the Colony Loop Community. The Department currently proposes serving approximately 50 hot, nutritious meals per day, four days a week of the current academic year and the beginning of the next academic year (September 30, 2014).
