Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with ENVIRONMENTAL SURVEY, INC., for vegetation control services at wet ponds in an amount not to exceed \$1,002,210, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$334,070 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,004,420.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$334,070 is available in the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Operating Budget of the Watershed Protection Department. Funding for the remaining 24 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation. Additional Backup Information

This contract will provide specialized aquatic vegetation control at the City's wet ponds. These ponds are designed to capture and hold stormwater runoff. This allows for the settling of suspended solids and removal of pollutants keeping them out of the local waterways and recharge zones. The services contracted will include maintenance of the specialized and specified plantings at the pond's edge as well as entry in the permanent pool to remove debris and excessive vegetation within the pond. Invasive woody plants will also be physically removed from each wet pond. This will be completed a minimum of three times a year.

The specialized maintenance will assist in ensuring each wet pond is compliant with the Environmental Criteria Manual as well as dam maintenance policies and procedures while following the wet pond Integrated Pest Management plan.

An evaluation committee comprised of personnel from Watershed Protection evaluated the bid independently to predefined evaluation criteria, an environmental survey addressed the unique requirements of the City in all areas defined by the scope of work.
