**Additional Backup Information**

On June 3, 2014, the City of Austin began the official 90-day period requesting nominations from the general public to name the parkland.

After the 90-day period, which ended on September 1, 2014, the Parks and Recreation Department received two (2) nominations for the re-naming of the park. On September 8, 2014, the Land, Facilities and Programs Committee of the Parks and Recreation Board heard public comment on the suggested names and forwarded the name Vic Mathias Shores to the Parks & Recreation Board for action. On September 23, 2014, the Parks and Recreation Board voted to recommend to the City Council the name Vic Mathias Shores.
