## ORDINANCE NO. 20140925-133

AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE CLAPPART-BANNERMAN-CASTRO HOUSE LOCATED AT 1207 EAST 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET IN THE CENTRAL EAST AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN AREA FROM FAMILY RESIDENCE-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT TO FAMILY RESIDENCE-HISTORIC LANDMARK-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (SF-3-H-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1.** The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from family residence-neighborhood plan (SF-3-NP) combining district to family residence-historic landmark-neighborhood plan (SF-3-H-NP) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14H-2014-0009, on file at the Planning and Development Review Department, as follows:

Lot 8, Block 1, Outlot 4, Division B, Stuart & Mair Subdivision, a subdivision in the City of Austin, according to the map or plat of record in Plat Book W, Page 230, of the Official Public Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),

generally known as the Clappart-Bannerman-Castro House locally known as 1207 East 8<sup>th</sup> Street, in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit "A".

**PART 2.** The Property is subject to Ordinance No. 011213-42 that established the Central East Austin neighborhood plan combining district.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on October 6, 2014.
