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ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

One of the top priorities in the Parks and Recreation Department’s Long Range Plan is acquiring parkland along Onion Creek. The proposed 27.11 acre acquisition could provide a future trail head and other more active recreational opportunities along a beautiful stretch of flood prone Onion Creek.

The property is bounded by Slaughter Lane to the west, Brandt Road to the north, Bluff Springs to the east and Onion Creek to the south. The property has over 2,000 linear feet of frontage along Onion Creek.

The Parks & Recreation Department will fund this proposed acquisition through parkland dedication funds and 2012 Bond Funds.

The purchase price of \$900,000 is under the current fair market value as determined by an independent third party appraiser.
