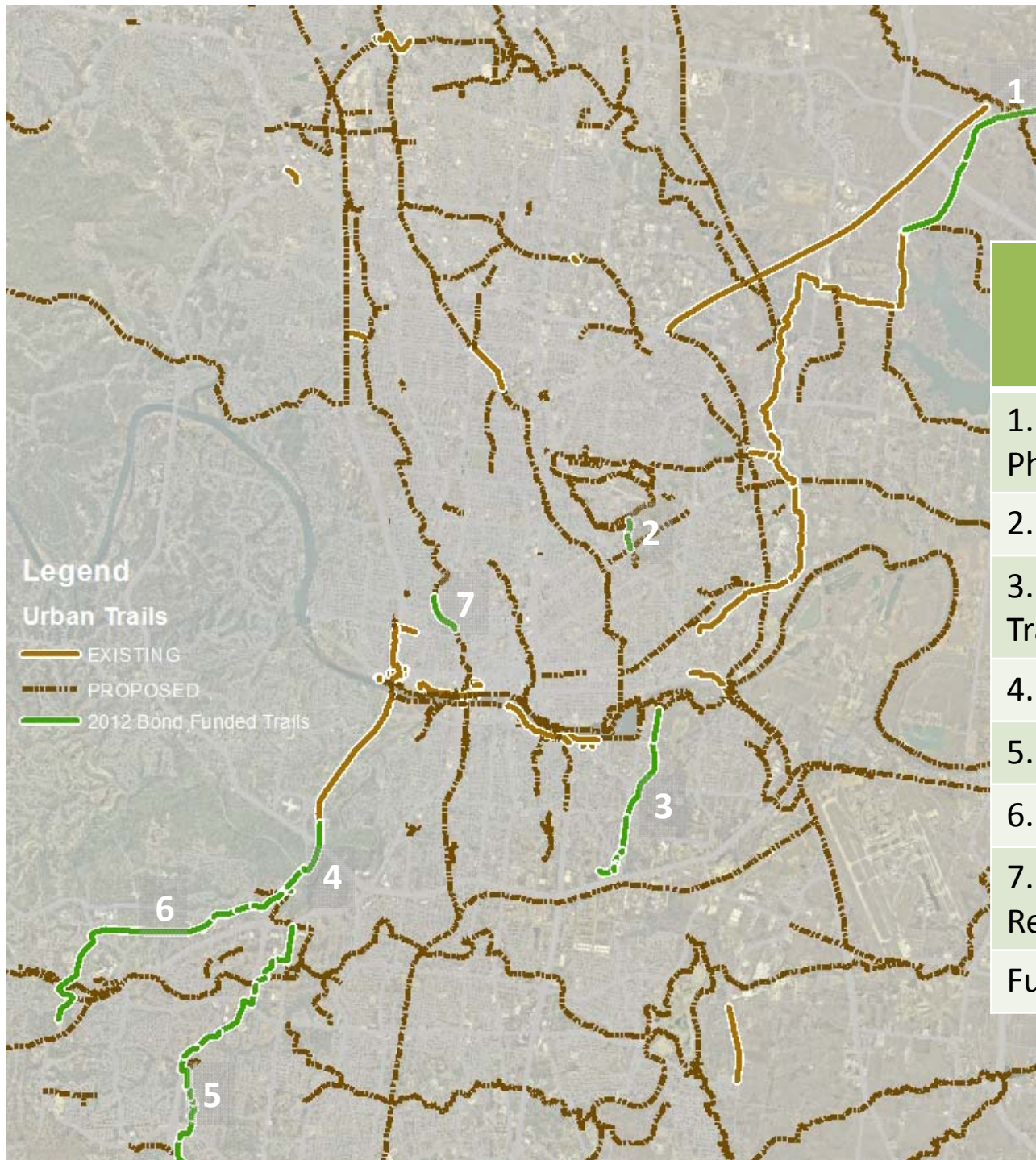
What is an Urban Trail?

- Hard surface,
- For recreation and transportation,
- For bicycles, pedestrians, rollerbladers, skateboarders, and those with disabilities,
- Typically 12' wide.

What is in the Urban Trails Master Plan?

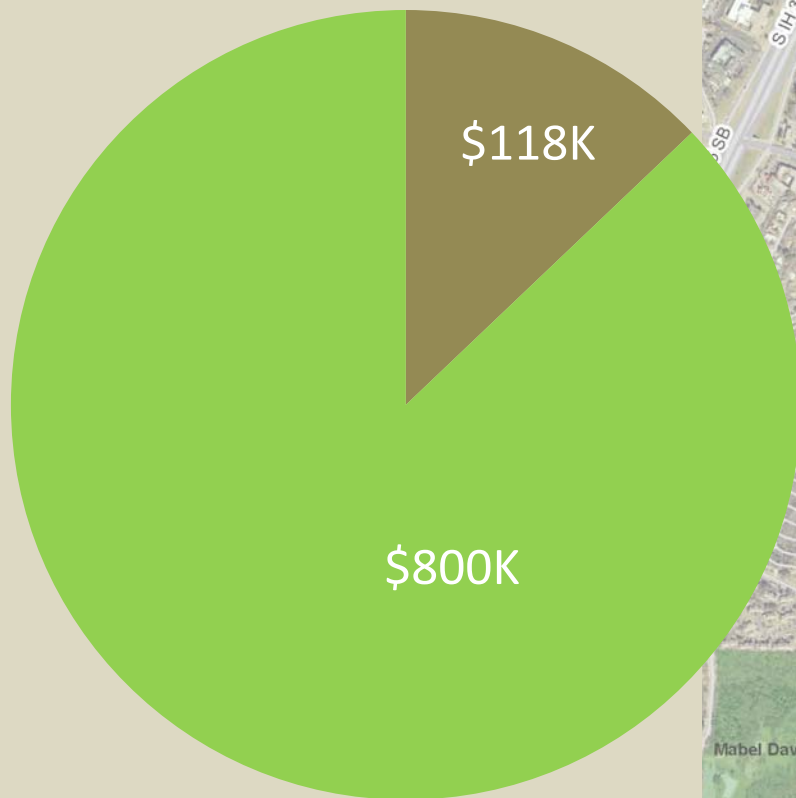
1. Interdepartmental consultation and coordination

3. Identify processes/plans for implementation



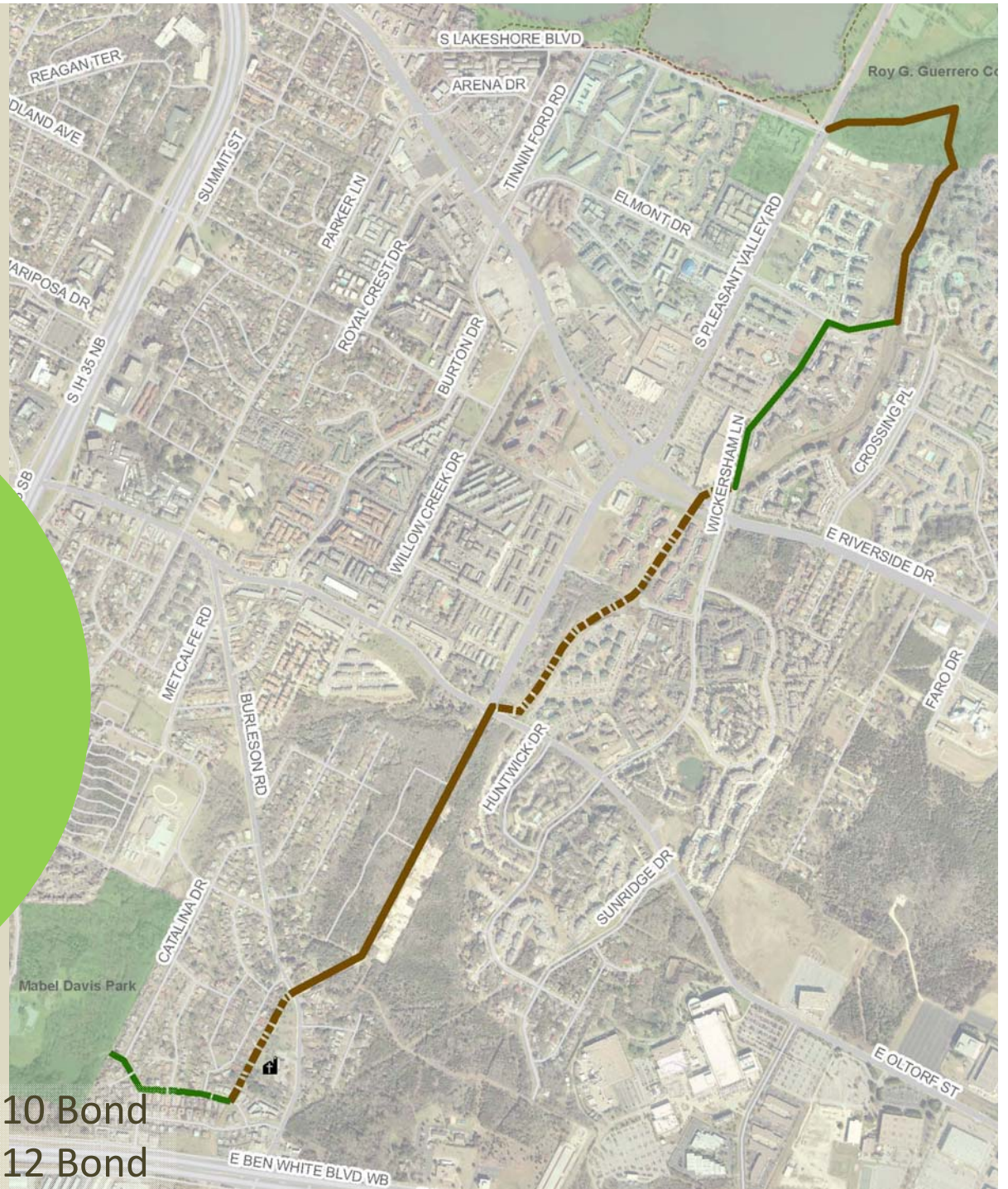

Future grant matches	\$1.1M

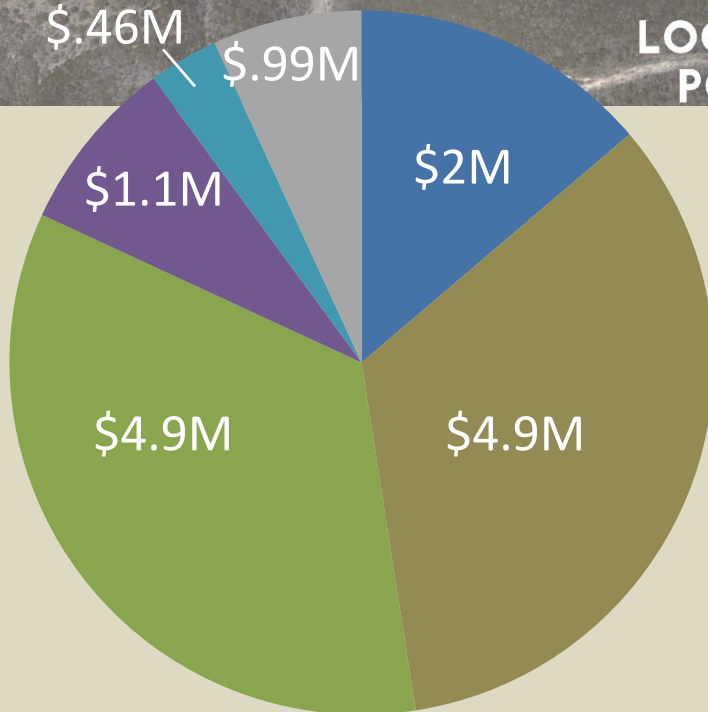
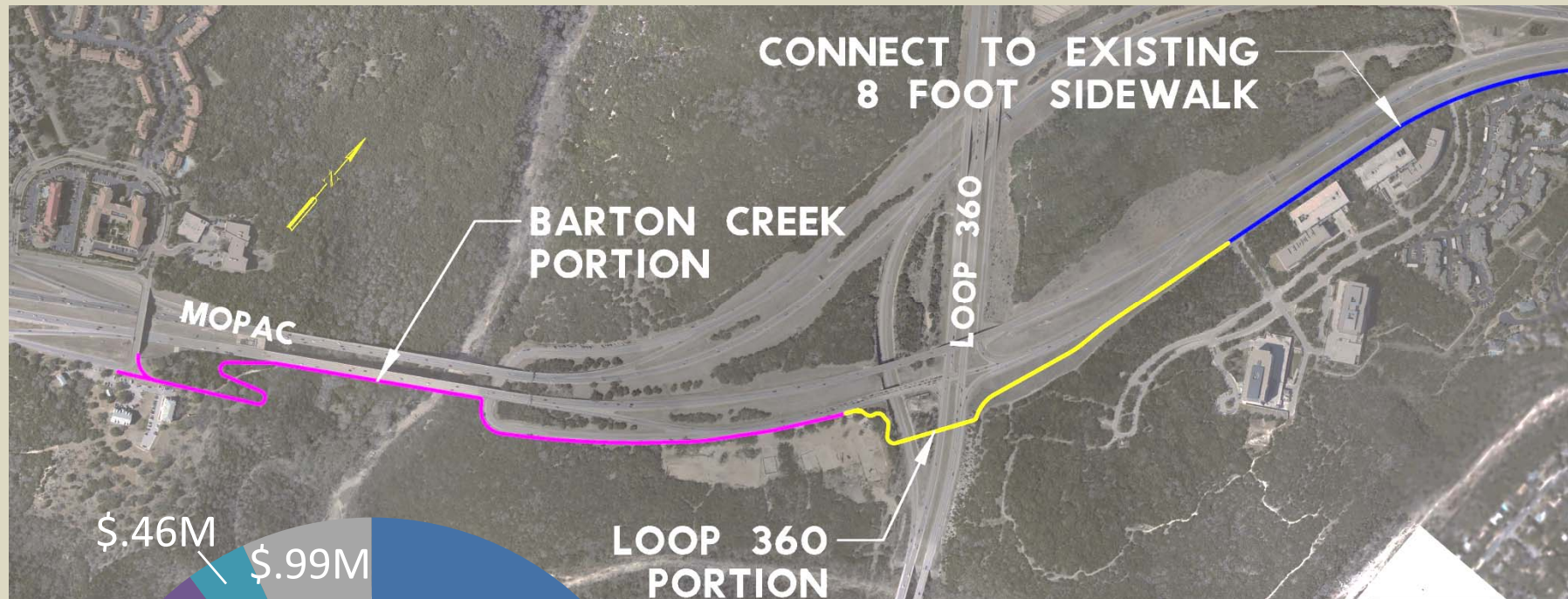

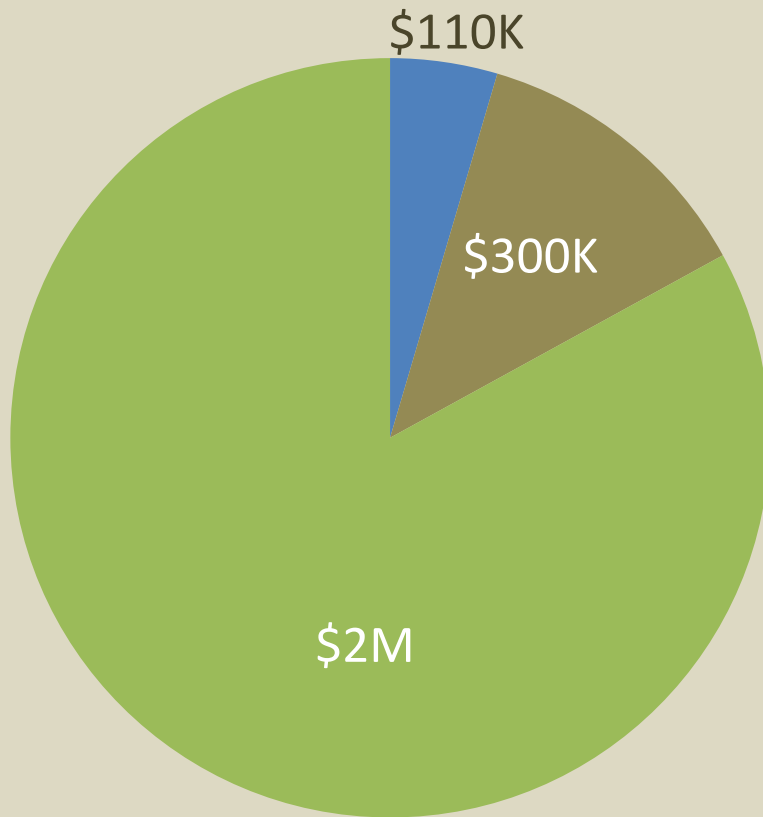

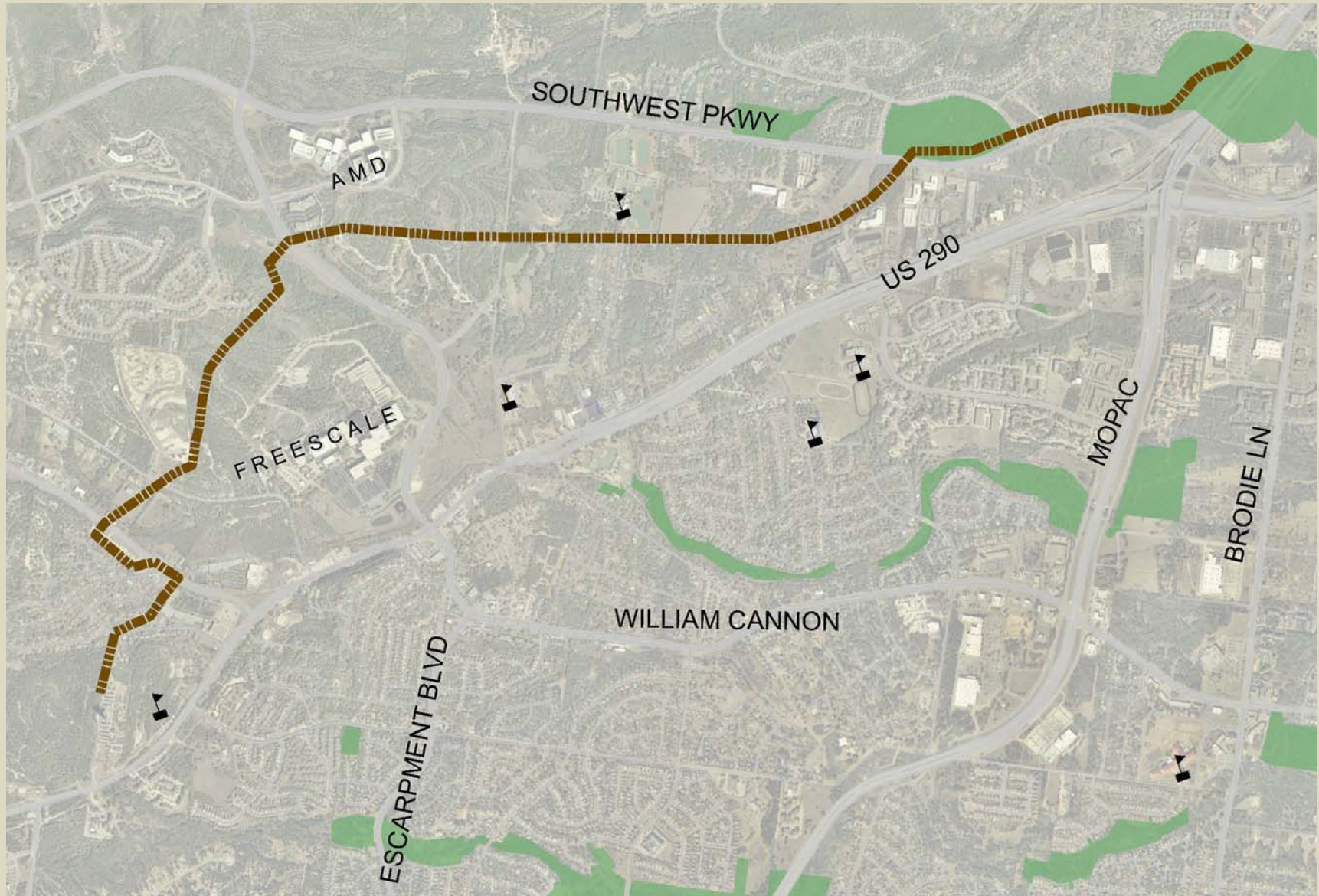
Violet Crown Trail: Phase II

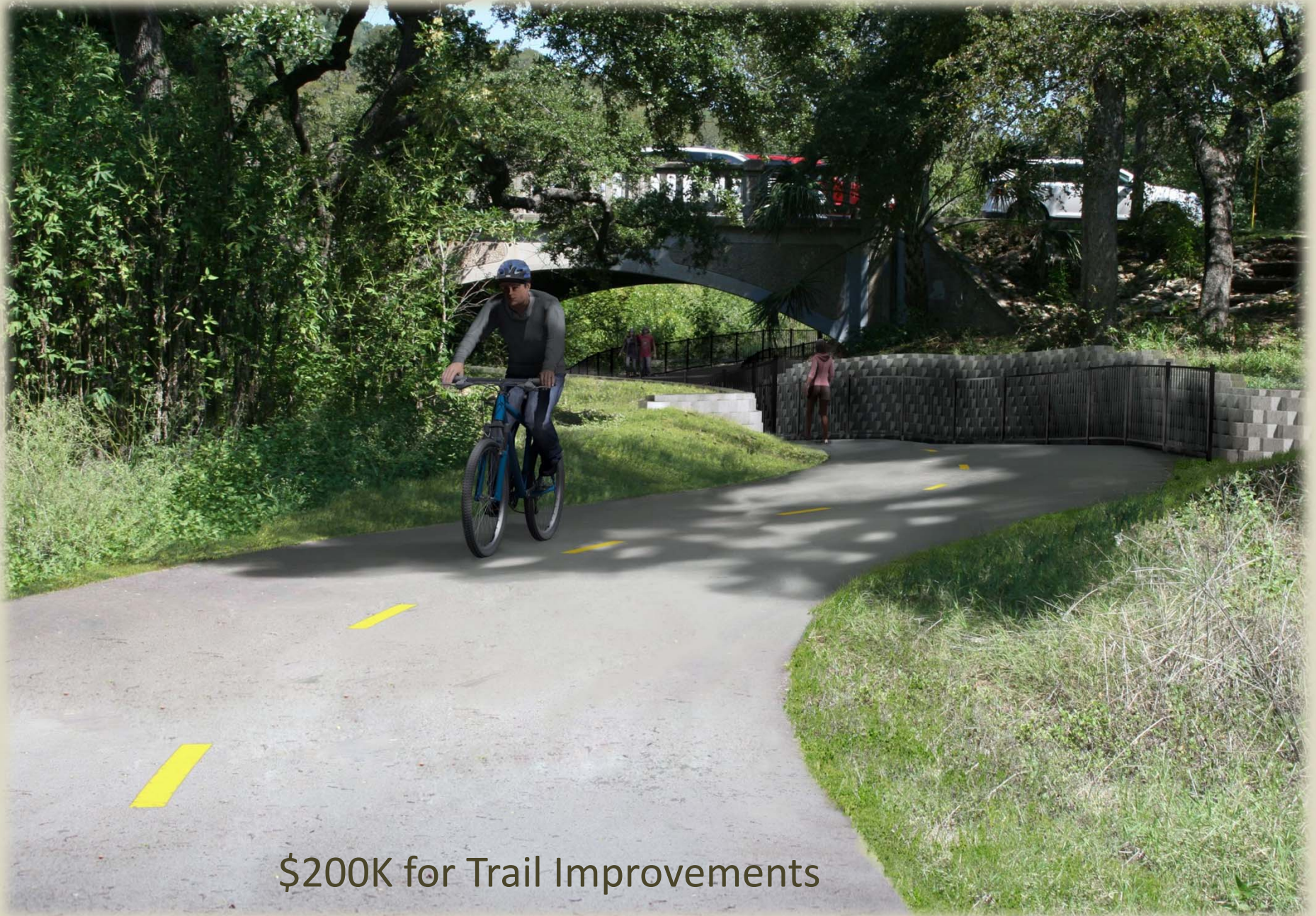
