## **Insurance Requirements and Year-End Insurance Review**

I move to amend Part 3 (B)(2) and to add a new subsection (3) to read as follows:

- (2) During the time period beginning when a TNC driver has logged into a TNC's digital network and indicated that they are available to receive requests for transportation until such time when the TNC driver accepts a request for transportation through the TNC's digital network, Transportation network company insurance shall be in the amount of at least thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for death and personal injury per person, sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for death and personal injury per incident, and twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for property damage. The requirements for the coverage required by this paragraph may be satisfied by any of the following:
  - (a) transportation network company insurance maintained by a participating driver;
  - (b) transportation network company insurance maintained by a transportation network company that provides coverage in the event a participating driver's insurance policy under subparagraph (a) has

ceased to exist or has been canceled, or the participating driver does not otherwise maintain transportation network company insurance pursuant to this subdivision;

- (c) any combination of subparagraphs (a) and (b); and
- (d) "transportation network company insurance" is defined as a liability insurance policy that specifically covers liabilities arising from a driver's use of a vehicle in connection with a transportation network company's online-enabled application or platform.
- (3) Data on insurance claims and the effectiveness of the coverages described in Sections (B)(1) and (B)(2) shall be submitted to the City for annual review. After review, this ordinance and the City's agreements with the TNCs may be amended to correct any deficiencies and improve insurance protection.
