Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements supply contract with ESI ACQUISITION, INC. for the purchase of WebEOC software, maintenance, and support for the Emergency Operations Center in an amount not to exceed \$27,070, with four 12-month extension options in amounts not to exceed \$15,522 for the first option, \$15,988 for the second option, \$16,468 for the third option and \$16,468 for the fourth option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$91,516.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$27,070 is available in the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Operating Budget of Communications and Technology Management, Combined Transportation, Emergency and Communications Center (CTECC). One third of the cost is reimbursed to the City by Travis County. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon funding availability in future budgets.

This contract is for the purchase of WebEOC software with continuing maintenance and support. WebEOC is an emergency management solution used by the City's Homeland Security Emergency Management and Travis County Emergency Management to direct, administer, and coordinate disaster response. WebEOC is a critical communications tool for emergency management personnel and first responders to use during and after an activation of the City's Emergency Operations Center at the Combined Transportation, Emergency and Communications Center. This solution provides a means to ensure public safety interoperability and the real-time exchange of information among city, county and state public safety officials during a disaster.
