August 26, 2010 – Council approved an ordinance authorizing negotiation and execution of an amended and restated cost reimbursement agreement with Club Deal 120 Indian Hills, LP for construction of a 48 and 24 inch water main; for the design of a wastewater treatment plant. ## Additional Backup Information

In related items on the November 20, 2014 agenda, Council will consider approval of the Indian Hills Public Improvement District (PID) 2015 Service Plan and Budget, setting the assessments for the PID, and approval of the proposed 2015 assessment roll. The proposed 2015 assessment rate is estimated to produce \$1,741,049. Assessments on real property fund the debt service, related reserves and administrative expenses of the PID.

State law requires a public hearing by Council to consider the proposed assessments. This action would set the public hearing on the Indian Hills PID 2015 assessments for December 11, 2014. Approval of the assessment and proposed roll on November 20, 2014 allows notices to be sent to the property owners, giving them an opportunity to review the property valuations prior to the public hearing. Property owners have a right to challenge their assessment at the hearing. At the hearing, Council must hear and pass on any objection, made orally or in writing, to any proposed assessment, prior to approval of the ordinance levying assessments and setting the method of collection and rate of interest for late payments.
