- CodeNEXT team provides background
 - Current code requirements
 - Best practices
 - Suggested alternatives

PROCESS

- Working group prepares recommendations
- CAG reviews recommendations and presents recommendations to CodeNEXT team
- If no consensus, dissenting opinions included

- Working papers submitted to CAG by 3-31-15
- CAG reviews and takes public comment
- CAG makes recommendations by 4-30-15
