CodeNEXT Code Advisory Group: Resolution on an Approach for CodeNEXT

Whereas the selection of a preferred Approach establishes a general framework for the new code;

And whereas successful completion of the CodeNEXT requires that a schedule be kept to in order to finish the project in a timely manner;

And whereas the current postponements in making a choice have delayed some work efforts for what will be four weeks by November 20;

And whereas there appears to be support to approve Approach 2 or Approach 3;

And whereas there will be opportunities for additional discussion, public review and input, and changes to proposed new code content;

And whereas the CodeNEXT Advisory Group adopted a compromise between Approach 2 or Approach 3 and Council member Martinez offered the same hybrid Approach as an unseconded motion on November 6;

Therefore, the CodeNEXT Advisory Group asks the City Council to make a choice among Approach 2, Approach 3, or a compromise, and wishes the City Council to understand that the CAG believes it is much more important to make a decision so we can move ahead than to postpone a decision any longer.
