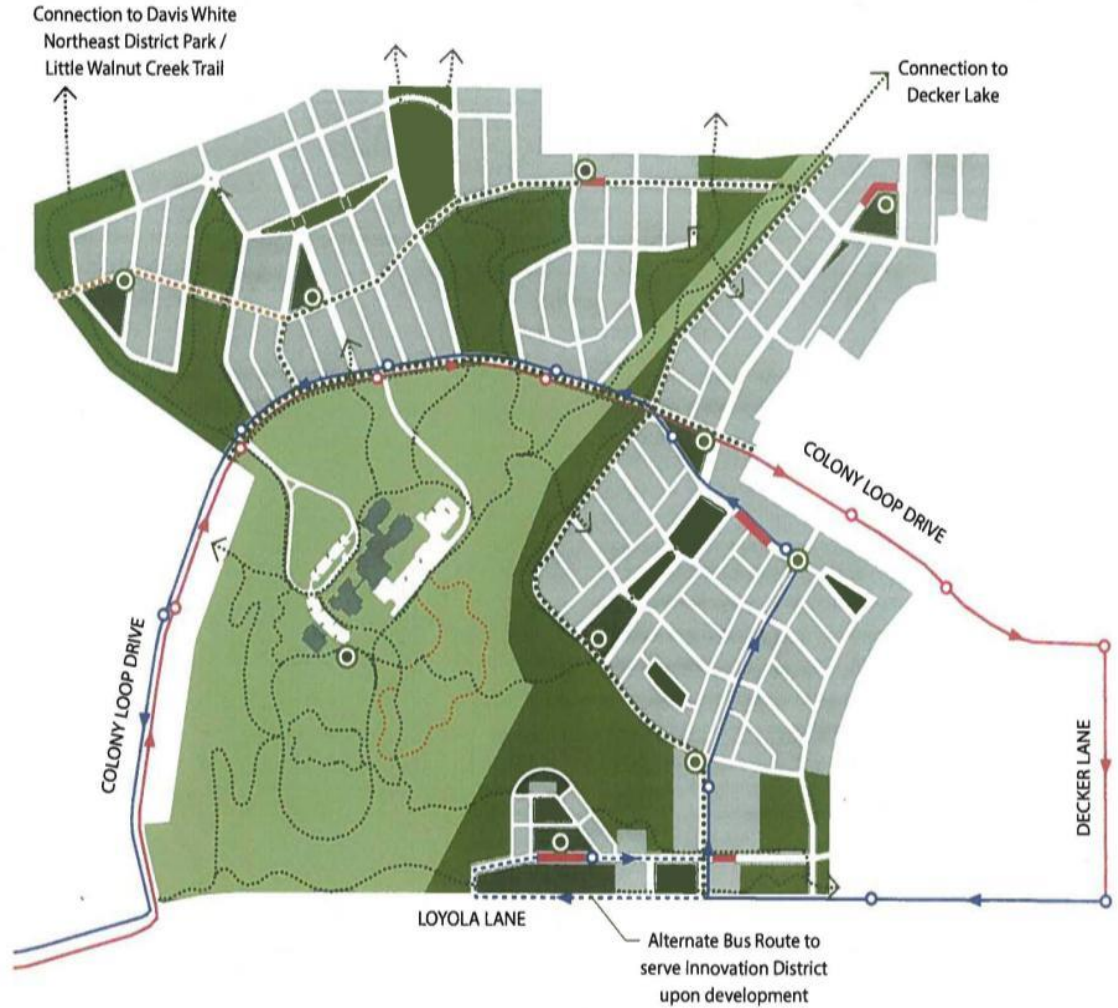
CPSCI Right Of Way Acquisition

- Current use of Parkland
- High Voltage electrical line easement
- Creates “Pan handle” space that averages 100’ in width



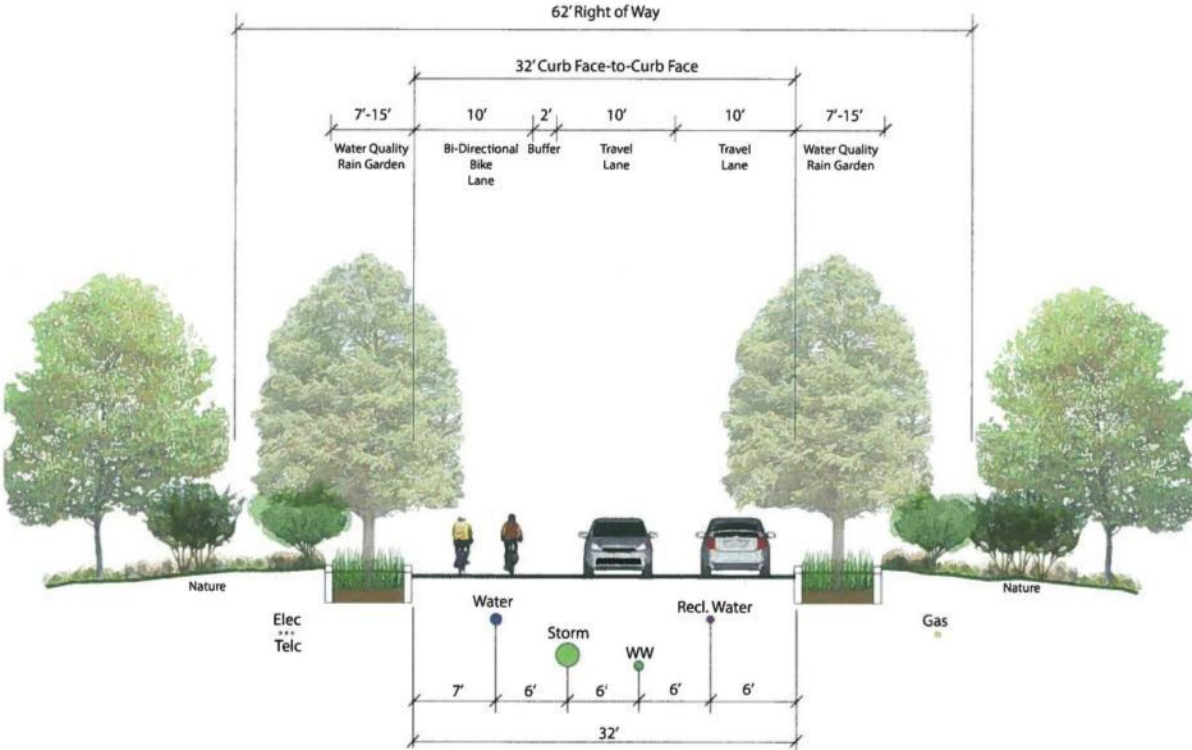
CPSCI Right Of Way Acquisition

 - Sidewalks



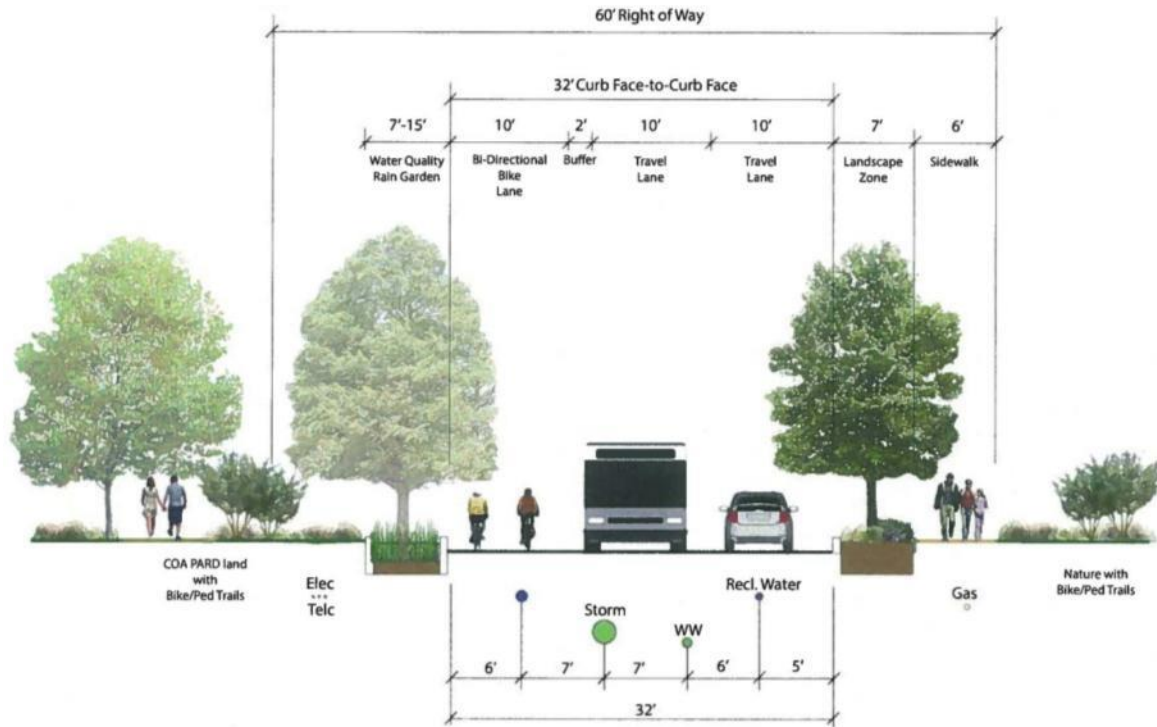
CPSCI Right Of Way Acquisition

- Type J: “Nature Street”
- Move through fingers of nature



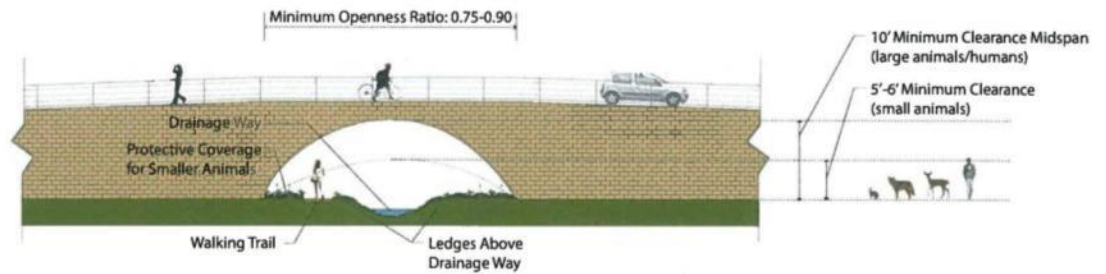
CPSCI Right Of Way Acquisition

- Movement of People

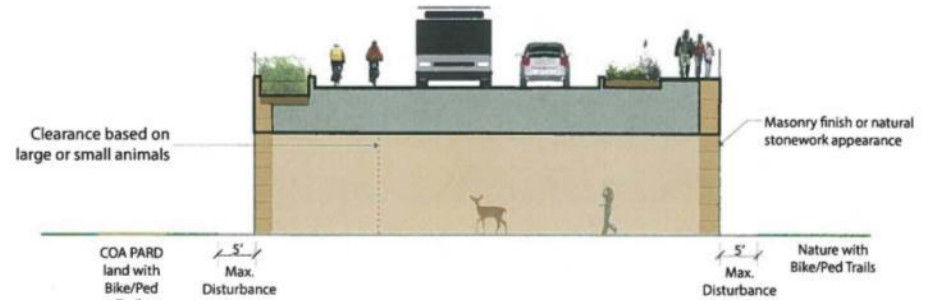


CPSCI Right Of Way Acquisition
