## Additional Backup Information

On August 28, 2014, City Council passed Resolution No. 20140828-084, which directed the City Manager to process code amendments that require gender-neutral signage for single-user restrooms.

The proposed code amendment requires the use of gender-neutral signage for single-user restrooms in commercial facilities. For existing restrooms, enforcement of the signage requirement will be complaint driven through the established 3-1-1 process. For commercial remodels and new construction, enforcement of the signage requirement will occur during the permit inspection process.
