

ITEM 204 - Ordinance amending City Code Chapter 2-1 relating to boards and commission

Mayor Pro Tem Cole

Regarding the African American Resource Advisory Commission, I would like to have Council identify the specific stakeholder groups from which the additional four members mentioned in Part 7, section E would represent.

I am making the following motion. To amend Part 7 section D to include the George Washington Carver Museum and Cultural Center and the African American Cultural Heritage District and to amend section E to strike "community stakeholders" and amend section (E) to increase the number of stakeholder groups to six. Those six groups would be the Austin Revitalization Authority, the Greater Austin Black Chamber of Commerce, and the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Austin Area Urban League, African American Cultural Heritage District Community Advisory Board, and the George Washington Carver Ambassadors."

PART 7. City Code Section 2-1-101 (*African American Resource Advisory Commission*) 5 is amended by adding new Subsections (D) and (E) to read:

- (D) The commission shall advise the council on matters related to the African American Cultural and Heritage Facility, the George Washington Carver Museum and Cultural Center and the African American Cultural Heritage District.
- (E) In addition to the 11 members nominated by the council, the council shall appoint four six additional members nominated by the commission who represent community stakeholders the Austin Revitalization Authority, the Greater Austin Black Chamber of Commerce, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, and the Austin Area Urban League, the African American Cultural Heritage District Community Advisory Board, and the George Washington Carver Ambassadors.
