Historic Landmark Commission MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING Monday, November 17, 2014

The Historic Landmark Commission convened in a regular hearing on Monday, November 17, 2014 at City Council Chambers, 301 W. 2nd Street, in Austin, Texas.

Commissioner Mary Jo Galindo called the public hearing to order at 7:12 p.m.

The first three speakers signed up prior to the meeting being called to order will each be allowed a three-minute allotment to address their concerns regarding items not posted on the agenda.

Louisa Brinsmade and Bruce Sheehan spoke in support of historic designation for the Stasswender family compound at 1306 Waller St., 811 E 6th St., and 807 E 16th St. Commissioner Terri Myers will bring forth a report on the homes at the next meeting.

DISTRICT ZONING APPLICATIONS, and REQUESTS TO CONSIDER THE
INITIATION OF A HISTORIC ZONING CASE

1. Un-numbered

Pine Street Station, 414 Waller Street

The case comes on the citizen communication by Reji Thomas and Liz Purcell for the Commission to consider the initiation of ahistoric zoning case for the ca. 1925 Humble Oil and Refining Company warehouse, also known as Pine Street Station.

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454 Staff Recommendation: Staff makes no recommendations on citizen requests for Commission initiation of historic zoning.

Elizabeth Purcell spoke to request postponement for the public hearing in order to complete a historic status report.

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014, on a motion by Commissioner Myers; Commissioner Roberts seconded on a 5-0 vote.

2. C14H-2013-0005

Old Judges' Hill Local Historic District

Roughly bounded by West Avenue on the east, 15th Street on the south, Shoal Creek Boulevard on the west, and W. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard on the north.

Applicants: Bob Swaffar and Mark Seeger, Old Judge's Hill Historic District Committee

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454 Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic district zoning.

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014, per staff request, in order to correct notice/mapping errors.

Bluebonnet Hills Local Historic District

Roughly bounded by Annie Street on the north, East Side Drive on the east, Leland Street on the south, and Brackenridge Street on the west.

MOTION: Proceed with the public hearing on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion; vote 5-0.

Michelle Reed, Katie Gallagher, Caleb Brewer, Jane Downer, Natalie Martinez, Brent Hunter, Linda Chien, Carol Grimes, Emily Reed, and Michele Webre spoke in favor of local historic district zoning. Arif Panju, Miriam Panju, and Candelario Moreno spoke in opposition to historic zoning. Kate Singleton asked for staff clarification on routine maintenance procedures and spoke in rebuttal.

The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Wolfenden. Commissioner Myers seconded the motion; vote: 5-0.

MOTION: Recommend Blue Bonnet Hills as a Local Historic District in accordance with staff recommendation on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded the motion; vote: 5-0.

4. C14H-2014-0015

R.W. and Ida Mae Gissell House

513 E. Annie Street

Applicant: Brent Hunter, owner

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning.

Brent Hunter spoke in favor of historic zoning. There were no speakers in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded the motion; vote: 5-0.

MOTION: Recommend historic zoning in accordance with staff recommendation on a motion by Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry. Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion; vote: 5-0.

B. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATES OF APPROPRIATENESS

1. C14H-1990-0007 - Nelson Davis Warehouse

117 W. 4th Street

Proposal: Construct a new rooftop storefront and canopy; signage.

Applicant: RA Sushi Restaurant

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Committee Recommendation: Not reviewed

Staff Recommendation: Approve the demolition of the existing "temporary" storefront and the construction of the new storefront; deny the application to extend the canopy any further than the previously approved 15 feet behind the front parapet wall; deny the roof signage altogether, and deny the lighting for the over-door and blade signs, recommending indirect rather than internally-lit lighting in conformance with the sign standards for historic landmarks and historic districts.

John McCall and Loretta Reeves spoke in favor of the Certificate of Appropriateness. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded; vote 5-0.

COMMENT: Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry suggested that the applicant follow sign guidelines, review the property history, and review past approvals by the Commission

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014, on a motion by Commissioner Wolfenden. Commissioner Myers seconded the motion; vote: 5-0.

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014 per the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded the motion; vote 5-0.

1208 W. 8th Street (West Line)

Proposal: Demolish a contributing house.

Applicant: Kris Owens

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Either postpone to December 15, 2014 under the Commission's 180-day demolition delay process, or release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, and upon review of the plans for a new structure for the site.

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014 per the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded the motion; vote 5-0.

4. NRD-2014-0097

3302 Funston Street (Old West Austin) – POSTPONE TO DECEMBER 15, 2014 to allow the applicant to complete zoning review.

MOTION: Postpone the public hearing to December 15, 2014 per the consent agenda on a motion by Commissioner Myers. Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry seconded the motion; vote 5-0.

Staff Recommendation: Set the rooftop activities, vegetation, and trees back from the parapet in accordance with the Architectural Design Guidelines for Sixth Street.

Applicant: Ken Johnson, Michael Hsu Architects

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454 Staff Recommendation: 78 and 84 Rainey Street: Approve as proposed with the recommendation of not installing the large side windows to preserve all historic fabric on the sides of the houses, and the completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package. 80 and 82 Rainey Street: Encourage relocation over demolition for the house at 80 Rainey Street, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package; approve the plans for the new event venue as proposed.
