**WHEREAS**, Janet Long Fish, has been an active community member serving the Austin community for more than 60 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Janet Long Fish has devoted most of her life to beautifying Austin by designing and developing the Shoal Creek hike and bike trail system, and by personally planting and maintaining hundreds of flowers and fruit trees throughout Austin; and

**WHEREAS**, Janet Long Fish demonstrated her commitment to the children of Austin by starting the West Austin Christmas Party for neighborhood children and forming the Junior Deputies; and

**WHEREAS**, Janet Long Fish served on numerous local and national organizations such as Heritage Society of Austin, Austin History Center, and Daughters of the American Revolution, and she supported many other organizations including the Austin Founders Trail Ride, Austin Steam Train Association, and the Austin Area Garden Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Janet Long Fish family is now developing their land in northeast Austin and will be dedicating 27.87 acres of their land for park purposes, a portion of which meets the requirements of the parkland dedication ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, City Code Section 14-1-33(I) provides that Council, by resolution, may establish different procedures for the naming of a particular facility; **NOW, THEREFORE**,


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**


