Imagine Austin & CodeNEXT Work to Date

- Oct 2009 Council initiates Imagine Austin process
- June 2012 Imagine Austin adopted by Council
- Oct 2012 Council briefed on proposed process to revise Land Development Code
- Jan-Feb 2013 Code Advisory Group appointed
- Mar 2013 Opticos Design selected by Council

- July 2013 CodeNEXT project kick-off
- Sept 2013 Apr 2014 Listening & Understanding phase
- Apr 2014 Listening to the Community Report
- May 2014 Code Diagnosis & Community Character Manual

- Nov 2014 Council selection of Approach 2, with amendments




