**PURPOSE:** The Board of Commissioners primary responsibility is to oversee the implementation and compliance of approved Urban Renewal Plans that are adopted by the Austin City Council. An Urban Renewal Plan's primary purpose is to eliminate slum and blighting influence within a designated area of the city.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – Approval of the October 20, 2014 Regular Meeting Minutes.  
**The motion to approve the October 20, 2014, regular meeting minutes was made by Commissioner McKee, seconded by Commissioner Babb and approved on a 6-0-0 vote.**

**The motion to approve the scoring criteria for the disposition of Block 16 and to bring back the Request for Proposal before release was made by Commissioner Babb, seconded by Commissioner Kirk and approved on a 6-0-0 vote.**
- b. Discussion and possible action on proposed non-substantive modifications to the East 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets Urban Renewal Plan.  
**A motion to approve non-substantive revisions to the Urban renewal plan and integrate all previous amendments was made by Commissioner Kirk, seconded by Commissioner Sunstrum, and approved on a 6-0-0 vote.**
- c. Discussion and possible action on proposed modification to the East 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets Urban Renewal Plan as it relates to the 1100 Block of East 11<sup>th</sup> Street (Block 18).
