Overview

FAQ: Existing Lady Bird Lake Excursion Boat Services

- Existing Contract: 01/01/2001 to 2/28/2015 (15 Years).
- Vendor provided all personnel, equipment, and other resources.
- Vendor conducts public tours and private charters year around.
- Contractor furnished a fleet of 3 boats
- Percentage of gross sales as revenue to City: 8%.

Request For Proposals: Project Goals

Project Goals:

- Exceptional Experience
 - Excellent customer service and marketing. Quality food and beverage service.
- American Disabilities Act Compliance
 - Improvements to parkland to provide accessibility.
- Operational Efficiency
 - Eliminate use of parkland for parking and off/on loading by vendor
 - Eliminate any conflict of concession operation with trail use.
- Expansion of Service
 - Partnerships with other entities on lake to expand opportunities and access to concession service.
- Environment Concerns
 - Vendor shall further City environmental goals through clean ups and programming and operations.
- Public Safety
 - Safety plan, experience captains and staff, and excellent track record.

Proposal Key Terms

Lone Star Riverboat, Inc. Proposal

• Term:

- One (1) five year primary term, one (1) five year extensions.
- Total: 10 year term

ADA site work

 Contractor will construct ADA compliant ramp and associated paths and parking space from Auditorium Shores Trailhead Parking to boats.

Increase in revenue:

Increase of revenue from current 8 to 9 percent.

Increase in fleet

Contractor proposes increasing the capacity of the fleet
