- 1. 2014-0078: Officer Involved Shooting / Critical Incident. On January 25, 2014 an APD officer discharged his weapon at 9401 North IH-35.
- 2. 2014-0662: Officer Involved Shooting / Critical Incident. On July 24, 2014 APD officers responded to a Suicide/HotShot call at 2201 Willow Creek Drive and discharged a less-than-lethal beanbag at a subject.
- 3. 2014-0595: The complainant alleges that the assigned detective did not thoroughly investigate her complaint.
- 4. 2014-0778: The complainant alleges that a supervisor retaliated against for filing a complaint.
