**Additional Backup Information**

The Capital Area Council of Governments operates the master agreement for the Regional Notification System (RNS) for a 10-county region. The City utilizes the RNS for the purpose of warning or alerting citizens regarding information in an emergency situation where property or human life is in jeopardy. It is a computer-based system that uses phone numbers and addresses maintained by the 9-1-1 system, as well as a cell phone registration system, to warn people in a given area of any imminent emergencies. This interlocal agreement supersedes the previous agreement. No funding is required from the City.
