**SUBJECT:** Approve an ordinance amending the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Austin Transportation Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20140908-001) to accept grant funds from the Texas Department of Transportation in the amount of \$200,000; and amending the Austin Transportation Department Capital Budget (Ordinance No. 20140908-002) to transfer in and appropriate \$200,000 from the Austin Transportation Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund for the installation of bicycle signals and bicycle detection equipment at specific intersections within the city.

**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** On December 13, 2012, Council approved Item No. 28 supporting and approving the application for a 2012 Transportation Enhancement grant to install bicycle signals and detection at specific intersections throughout the City. On June 26, 2014, Council approved Item No. 63 authorizing the negotiation and execution of the Advance Funding Agreement with Texas Department of Transportation for this grant in the amount of \$250,000 with a 20% local match of \$50,000. Based on these previous Council actions, this item will accept these grant funds and transfer the amount to the Capital Budget. The General Fund will not be required to contribute to this grant.
