





Environmental Requirements



WATER:

- Developer agrees for water source to be approved by City Council
- Developer prefers to utilize the 3,000 foot deep Hosston well consisting of brackish hot water suitable for irrigation
- Hosston well is unsuitable as a direct potable water source and will not impact City of Austin water resources
- City maintains all of its rights to any groundwater beneath WEL Park

Environmental Requirements



LAKE:

- Project will not interfere with the City's use of Lake Walter E. Long
- Developer has no rights to water use from the lake
- City has no obligation to keep lake levels up to a certain level for aesthetic appeal

Environmental Requirements



PROTECTION:

- A 150 foot development buffer established from the shoreline of the lake
- Developer will create an Integrated Pest Management plan for pesticide use
- Developer will work with Watershed Protection Department during design process
