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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTERS 9-2 (NOISE AND AMPLIFIED SOUND) AND 9-4 (PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES) RELATING TO AUDIBLE NOISES AND MUSIC AND SOLICITATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** City Code Section 9-2-2 (*Applicability*) is amended to remove Subsection (B).
- **PART 2.** City Code Sections 9-2-3 (*General Restrictions*) is amended to read as follows: § 9-2-3 GENERAL RESTRICTIONS.
 - (A) A person may not:
 - (1) use or permit the use of sound equipment at a business <u>that produces</u> sound
 - (a) in excess of <u>85 decibels between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m., as</u> measured at the property line of the business; or
 - (b) is plainly audible at the property line of the business between 2:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.[the decibel limits prescribed by this chapter];
 - (2) <u>use or permit the use of sound equipment at a residence that produces</u> sound
 - (a) in excess of 75 decibels at the boundary line of the residence; or
 - (b) <u>is plainly audible at the boundary line of the residence between</u> 10:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.;
 - (3) make noise or play a musical instrument <u>that is plainly</u> audible <u>from the boundary line of the nearest</u> [to an adjacent] business or <u>residentially occupied property</u> [residence]
 - (a) between 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. in the following areas
 - (i) 600 to 900 blocks of Red River Street;
 - (ii) Sixth Street District;

1 2	(2) in a bus, at a bus station or stop, or at a facility operated by a transportation authority for passengers;
3	(3) within 25 feet of:
4	(a) an automated teller facility;
5	(b) the entrance or exit of a bank; or
6	(c) the entrance or exit of a check cashing business; or
7	(4) at a marked crosswalk;
8 9	(5) on either side of the street on a block where a school attended by minors or childcare facility has an entrance or exit;
10 11	(6) at a sidewalk café authorized under Chapter 14-4 (<i>Sidewalk Cafes</i>) or the patio area of a bar or restaurant; [or]
12	(7) between 1:00 am and 7:00 am in the following areas:
13	(i) 600 to 900 blocks of Red River Street;
14	(ii) Sixth Street District as defined in Section 9-2-1 (Definitions); or
15	(iii) Warehouse District as defined in Section 9-2-1 (Definitions); or
16 17 18	(8) in the downtown business area described in Section 9-4-14 (Sitting or Lying Down on Public Sidewalks in the Downtown Business Area Prohibited) between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m
19 20 21 22	PART 6. Six months after the effective date of this ordinance, the City Manager shall report to Council on any issues related to blocked entrances and exits and abuse of amplified sound that result from this ordinance and also any recommendations to address the issues.
