A request has been received for the vacation of approximately 8,200 square feet of the unconstructed Christopher Street right-of-way (adjacent to 1000 South 2nd Street).

The area requested for vacation is being planned for redevelopment to include single-family residential properties. Property owners within 300 feet of the area to be vacated were notified on April 11, 2014.
