

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING FRIDAY, MARCH 6, 2015

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called Meeting on Friday, March 6, 2015, City Hall, 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the meeting to order at 9:25 a.m. Council Member's Kitchen and Renteria absent.
