Megan Wells moved the Animal Advisory Commission make a recommendation to City Council to direct the City Manager to explore a more robust and accessible web presence with Corporate PIO for Animal Services Office and to include online applications for the adoption, foster and volunteer programs. Megan Wells moved the Animal Advisory Commission recommend City Council allocate funding for two full-time temporary staff for dog walking and enrichment for a minimum of one year. Larry Tucker seconded, motion passed by unanimous vote.

Larry Tucker moved the Animal Advisory Commission recommend to City Council to direct the City Manager to explore a contract with community organizations to work with Austin Animal Services on a 12-month pilot program focused on dog exercise and enrichment. Robert Shaw seconded, motion passed by unanimous vote.
