# HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION APRIL 13, 2015 DEMOLITION AND RELOCATION PERMITS HDP-2015-0103 4104 RAMSEY AVENUE

### PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1939-1940 house.

#### ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a full-width inset porch on plain, square, wood posts; 1:1 fenestration; integral one-car garage.

## RESEARCH

The house was built in 1939-1940 by the McNeley Construction Company of Austin. The first owners and occupants were Norwood and Margaret C. King, who lived here until around 1943. Norwood King was a clerk at the gas company; Margaret King was a district supervisor for the WPA, but there does not seem to be any other information about her besides what is contained in the city directory listing.

From 1943 to around 1960, the house was owned and occupied by the Christal family. Thomas and Julia Christal, along with their daughter, Elizabeth, are listed in the city directories. Thomas Christal was a real estate agent; Elizabeth Christal was a department manager for Buttrey's, a women's clothing store just west of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Congress Avenue.


The house appears to have been a rental property for much of the time since 1960.

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES**

## Norwood and Margaret King (ca. 1940 – ca. 1943)

Norwood King appears in the 1940 U.S. Census with his mother, Lula King, at what appears to be a boarding house at 1504 Congress Avenue. He was single, 24, and a clerk for the gas company. He had been born in Arkansas. His mother, Lula King, was a 45-year old Texasborn widow who did alterations for a dry cleaner. Norwood King died in Kerrville, Texas March 12, 1995. There was no obituary in the Austin newspapers. Margaret C. King died August 26, 1999.

## Elizabeth Christal; Thomas and Julia Christal (ca. 1943 – ca. 1960)

Thomas and Julia Christal appear in the 1940 U.S. Census as the renters of the house at 1823 W. 37<sup>th</sup> Street in Austin. Thomas Christal was 69, had been born in Texas, and was a real estate salesman. Julia Christal was 62, had been born in Texas, and had no occupation listed. With them lived 2 daughters, Margaret, 37, a grade school teacher; and Elizabeth, 27, a saleslady in a department store. Both women had been born in Texas.
