Alleys are identified as follows:

- a. North-South Alleys are named for the nearest parallel street to its west.
- b. East-West Alleys are named for the nearest parallel street to its south.

REMARKS:

- 1. This method of identification has been in use since prior to 1967 but never formally identified for the purpose of the Traffic Register.

Based upon a traffic engineering study, I find the above regulations necessary for the free flow and the expeditious handling of traffic and the safety of persons and property.
