



**Commission for Women  
MINUTES**

**REGULAR MEETING  
October 2, 2014**

The Commission for Women convened in a regular meeting on October 2, 2014 at One Texas Center, 505 Barton Springs Rd., Rm. 500, in Austin, Texas.

Vice-Chair Bope called the Board Meeting to order at 12:15 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

- Vice-Chair Flannery Bope asked commission members to review minutes from the meeting on September 4, 2014. Commissioner Naranjo moved to approve the September 4 minutes. Commissioner Aguilar seconded. Motion passed.

**STAFF BRIEFING**

- Melanie Miller, a representative from The Simple Dollar, asked the commission about putting a link to their website. Since the company is a private sector entity, and information about the company was vague, commissioners all agreed that it was not conducive for a city commission to have a link to this website.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- The election of officers must be conducted at commission's first regular meeting after October 1st. Officers shall be elected by a majority vote. The term of office begins in November.
