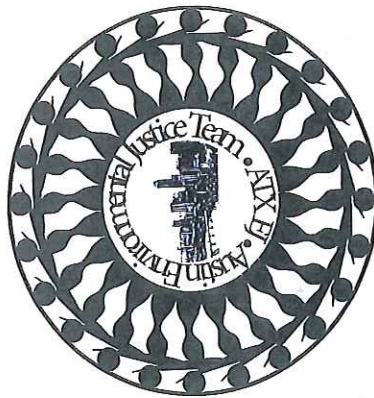


The Power of our Community: lowering electric bills and revitalizing our neighborhoods
