AIPP Ordinance


1985 = 1% of eligible CIP 2002 = 2% of eligible CIP eligible = buildings, parks, streetscapes, bridges and more

- Program Ordinance implemented by Program Guidelines, oversight by AIPP Panel, Arts Commission
- Artwork must be sited at, in, or near funding project/facility
- Staff works with AIPP Panel, project teams and the community

AIPP Collection

- Over 180 commissions completed Contract value \$9 million
- 50 in progress
 Contract value \$9.2 million

Funding: Bond, Cash, PPP, Master Agreements, Cultural Arts Fund



Process | Art in Public Places

AIPP Goals & Guidelines

- Expand citizens' experience with visual art and enable them to better understand their communities & their individual lives
- Commission works of art of redeeming quality that advance public understanding of the visual art
- Enhance the aesthetic quality of public places
- Nurture artistic vitality
- Encourage public dialogue that increases public understanding & enjoyment of visual art
- Encouragement of public interaction with public places








